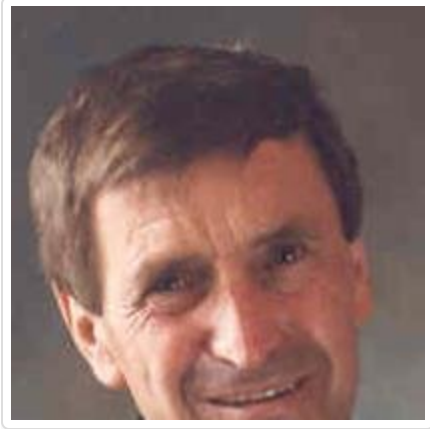




Billy E. Parrish
