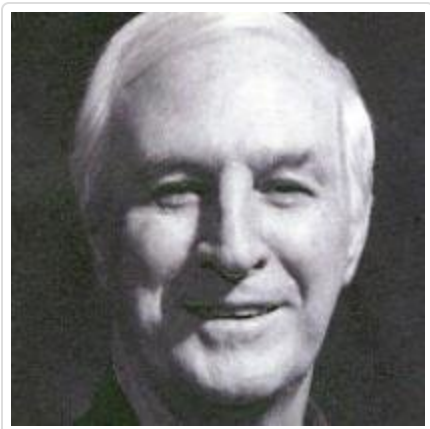




Byron "Barney" Wright
