



## Conrad Morton Moore

December 30, 1925 - December 1, 2003

Anderson - Conrad Morton "Red" Moore, 77, Anderson, died December 1, 2003 at I.U. Medical Center-Indianapolis after a brief illness. He was born December 30, 1925 in Sheridan, Indiana, and resided in Anderson, Indiana. He was a resident of this area for most of his life. He retired from supervision at Delco Remy Division of General Motors in 1982. He received a Bachelors degree from Ball State University in 1957. He served his country in the US Army during WWII as a 1st Sergeant in the 66th and 42nd Infantry Division. He received a Bronze Star, European Occupation Medal, Victory Medal, American Campaign, Combat Infantry Badge, Sharpshooter Medal and African-European Campaign Medal. He was a survivor of the USS Leopoldville sinking on December 24, 1944 in the English Channel. He was a former Boy Scout leader, Little League Baseball coach, High School teacher and basketball coach. He was an avid golfer, bowler and motorcycle enthusiast. He is survived by his wife whom he married February 1, 1947 in Tipton, Indiana, Helen Tishner Moore.
