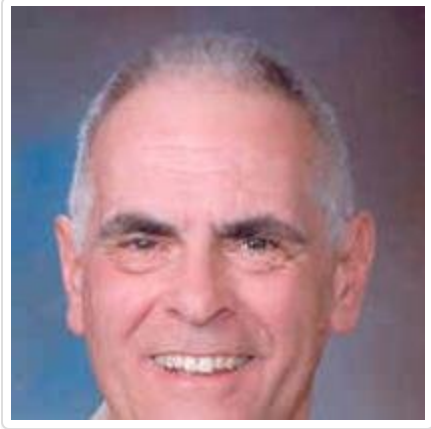




Fred W. Conner
