Anderson - Harry P. Cartwright, 82, Anderson, passed away August 28, 2007 at St. Johns Health System, Anderson Indiana after a brief illness. He was born December 7, 1924 in Auburn, Indiana to Harry W. and Dorothy Hiday Cartwright, and resided in Anderson for most of his life.
