



Jane Ann (Ford) Webber

January 18, 1940 - March 27, 2025

On March 27, Jane Ann (Ford) Webber from Lawrence, KS died. She was 85 years old.

Jane was crowned the honored queen of the Anderson Bethel 12 of the International Order of Job's Daughters in 1956. Jane married Jack Webber on

August 1, 1959, after meeting during Jane's senior year in high school. They welcomed Jeff in 1961 and Julie in 1969. Jane and Jack were the owners and operators of Jack Webber Real Estate ("Work with Webber, the Webber Way Works!") and Sophie's Decorator Shop from 1974 to 1981. They moved to Fort Myers, FL in 1981 where she worked as the Human Resources Manager for Mariner Group, Inc. and they lived there until their move to Lenexa, KS in 1994. Whilst in Kansas, Jane worked as the administrative assistant to the Asst. Superintendent of Blue Valley School District until her retirement. Her favorite hobbies included antiques, collecting white wicker furniture, decorating her home, visiting Vermont, and helping take care of her grandchildren. Jane and Jack were married for 56 years before Jack's death in 2014.
