Nancy Ellen (Schweikarth) Sutton, 79, resident of Lake Lemon, Unionville, IN, and formerly of Anderson and Evansville, passed away peacefully at home on April 3, 2022. She was born September 9, 1942, in Evansville, the second of five children to Arnold E. and Elsie M. Schweikarth.

Nancy was a 1960 graduate of North Posey High School. She graduated from Evansville Teacher's College (University of Evansville) in 1964 with a Bachelor of Education degree. Nancy then attended Indiana University where she met her future husband and graduated with a Master of Education degree in 1966. She later attended Ball State University to get her special education degree.
