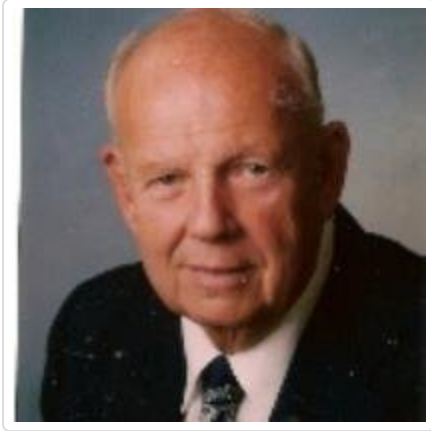




Robert E. "Bob" Page
