William E. Carrell, 87, of Anderson, passed away on June 30, 2023. He was born on October 9, 1935 in Stuttgart, AR, the son of Homer and Erna Carrell.

William attended Rhodes College and was a 1967 graduate of Christian Brothers University. He was elected to the Athletic Hall of Fame at Rhodes College.

William served as an E-4 SPC in the U.S. Army from 1958-60.

He retired as an electrical engineer from Guide Division of General Motors, after which he spent 20 years teaching post-secondary classes in the area.

William was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Anderson, Anderson Country Club, and was also a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon.

He was preceded in death by his son, David E. Carrell, his grandson, Joshua D. Carrell, his parents, his brothers, Finis Carrell and Scott Carrell, and his sisters, Nancy Whitley and Sue Dallas.

William is survived by his wife of 64 years, Mary Alice Carrell; his son, William Curtis Carrell; his grandson, Ronald Carrell (Brooke); and six great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren.
