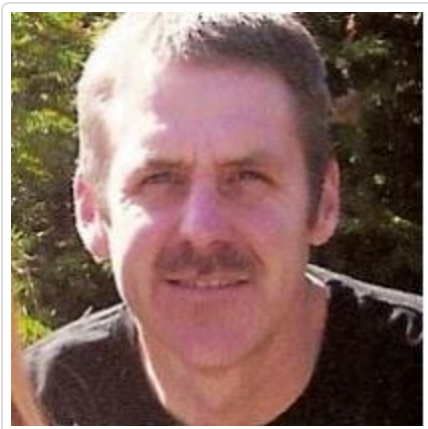




William A Overlin
